Min 84/08 Resident Issue

Min 88/08 Parish Council Meeting SBC

Cllr Tomlinson attended a meeting for Parish Councils' held at the Town Hall on the 1 May 2008. Cllr Tomlinson circulated to members present a Draft Agreement relating to the delegation of certain powers and duties of the Borough Council to the Parish Council. Cllr Tomlinson asked members to read through the document. Responses must be made by the end of June. Members were asked to bring the document to the next meeting.

MR WEST – NYCC HIGHWAYS

Mr West Area Manager NYCC Highways and Mr Andy Naylor Project Manager NYCC Highways attended the meeting to discuss the following questions:-

- Waiting Restrictions – Moor Lane, East Ayton
Mr West confirmed that the consultation process for the waiting restriction was already underway. It was confirmed that the bollards on Moor Lane would remain after the waiting restriction was introduced. Following a general discussion Mr West agreed that a timed restriction rather than an "Any Time" restriction would be more suitable.
- A170 Route Study
Mr West explained that the £50,000 budget was for the Route Study itself as well as the cost of design and construction works following the study.
- Point Scoring System – Prioritising Highway Improvements
Mr West outlined and explained the prioritisation system and provided a handout to members with specific scheme details to illustrate the system.
- Request for a VA Sign
Mr West explained that it was possible if not likely that a VA sign would be one of the recommendations from the A170 Route Study.

- A170 Roundabout Upgrading
Mr Naylor outlined the difficulties associated with altering the existing roundabout to any significant degree and circulated to members a schematic plan showing how additional land requirements would be the outcome of altering the existing roundabout position. It was confirmed that the roundabout is to be considered as part of the A170 Route Study.
- Visibility – Wilsons Lane Junction
Junction site line improvements would be impossible without the demolition of property which would not be possible.
- Double White Lines – B1261 Seamer Road
Mr West and Mr Naylor explained that double white lines within the 30mph limit were only possible in exceptional circumstances and then only with the agreement of North Yorkshire Police. It was agreed that Seamer Road beyond the 30mph limits would be surveyed with a view to providing a double white line system.

Mr West also announced to the meeting that the Whitby Area had secured funding for two Resurfacing and Reconstruction schemes within the Parish for this financial year. The first for resurfacing works on the A170 Racecourse Road towards Betton Farm and the second scheme for resurfacing works on Long Lane. Mr Naylor explained that the Long Lane scheme would probably consist of resurfacing three sections of Long Lane with a possibility of some footway works on Carr Lane, but that any new footway provision would need to be assessed under the prioritisation system. It was also explained that a weight limit would not be introduced because access would still have to be allowed to all properties and businesses on Long Lane as it is the only access route.

The Chairman thanked Mr West and Mr Naylor for attending the meeting.
