1. **The Chairman opened the meeting** welcomed those present and accepted received apologies. The secretary informed all in attendance that after over 13 years of attendance, Mr Agar was no longer able to attend future meetings due to a change of circumstance; a letter is to be written to Mr Agar.
2. **The minutes of the meeting** held on 14 December 2016 were agreed as accurate.
3. **Matters Arising** – Considerate Parking Scheme – no up-to-date figures have been obtained as yet but it is hoped they will be available in the near future. The Borough Council are keen on enforcement of the Scheme.

There have been no more instances of sheep worrying in the Brompton area. Snainton still has issues with speeding.

4. **Chairman's Report** – The Chairman stated that she was not aware of any issues since the last meeting but suggested to Members of the Group that she may make enquiries for

the forthcoming June meeting to see if it's possible for a visit to the Safer Communities Office at the Town Hall; the visit would be "police related". Information will be sent to Members as soon as feasibly possible.

5. **Police Report** – PCSO Newcombe gave a report on received crime statistics and explained that 18 (eighteen) crimes committed in the Seamer/Irton/Crossgates area had been committed at Morrisons Supermarket and Eastfield Industrial Estate.

There had been 4 thefts from unattended motor vehicles (some insecure) in Seamer; some had led to burglaries – one male has been arrested in relation to the incidents.

A light in the smoking area at The Mayfield Hotel had been damaged by a cigarette and a quad bike had been stolen – a male was arrested for the theft. A vehicle had been seized in a recent drug-driving offense. Traffic Officers are using a special kit to carry out the drugs tests, which can give results in good time to enable Officers to determine actions against offenders.

The Automatic Number Plate Recognition (APNR) vehicles are being deployed on trunk roads within the area.

There have been instances of ASB with youths being "spoken to", also theft of fuel and lorry and tractor batteries – enquiries are on-going.

There have been changes since our last meeting and PC Graham Bilton and PCSO Newcombe are both using Eastfield Police Station as a base. Their area has been increased in that the areas of Ravenscar and Staintondale are included in their patrol area. There are several PCSOs who are now training to become PCs so it is hoped that recruitment will take place and any new PCSOs will be kept in the Scarborough area.

7. **Items raised by members of the Group**

**Irton** – previous instances of ASB has been resolved as the perpetrator of the ASB has left the area. Steps are being taken to collate information regarding traffic collisions in the Stoney Hags roundabout area.

**Hutton Buscel** – a mattress that had been left in the area as a fly-tipping incident had been removed. Dog fouling was also an issue.

**Snainton** – dog fouling and speeding, instances of horse fouling appear to have diminished. Fly-tipping had been removed from the area.

**General discussion** – extensive renovations were almost complete at Sawdon Village Hall. Cllr Swillborne advised of a new contact for Sawdon Village Hall – noted by secretary.
