Before the meeting began, the secretary asked all present to sign the signing in sheet to show that they did not object to her keeping their names and address on a secure file in her possession (to satisfy the soon-to-be-introduced GDPR regulations)

- The Chairman opened the meeting:** The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting. Apologies had been received from Cllr S Willbourne (Brompton-by-Sawdon Council), Mrs E Mudd (Brompton-by-Sawdon resident), Cllr S Colley and R McIlroy (Wykeham Parish Council).
- The minutes of the meeting:** held on 13 December 2017 were agreed as accurate.
- Matters Arising:** Cllr Backhouse reported that a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) had been placed on green lanes in the area; it is hoped that the TROs will stop illegal use of green lanes.

4. **Police Report:** PC595 Graham Bilton attended the meeting giving an in-depth report (previously compiled) on both areas of GGD and GGU. PC Bilton explained that Richard Newcombe had been left the Force for some months but stated that the area now has PCSO Ria Lockey and PCSO Caroline Richman to swell the ranks. Overall crime for the whole area is down though some incidents were due to insecure vehicles and dwellings.

- On-going ASB at Ayton Bowling club means that there are raised patrols for the area which are greatly appreciated by WAPC;
- There has been an increase in vehicle seizures due to lack of insurance; the APNR vans will continue monitoring our area which was welcomed by all;
- Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP) talks are being given at Schools to raise awareness to children (and parents) on the dangers of some Internet sites.

PC Bilton took some questions from residents within the GGD area on parking concerns that have been on-going for two years and vehicles on the roadside "for sale". In-depth advice was given on who to contact and what actions to take.

5. **Items raised by members of the Public** As previously stated, residents within GGD area gave instances of serious parking issues where they live. Advice was given by PC Bilton and actions taken by residents the very next day; they were grateful that their concerns were supported and intend to attend future CaP meetings.

ACTION: Secretary also sent details of Considerate Parking Scheme to residents plus other advice to help them take their issues further.

6. **Items raised by members of the Group**

Seamer – instances of early morning speeding (PC Bilton to action monitoring)

Snainton – anecdotal instances of poaching occurring in the Snainton area – PC Bilton has visited farms within the area and given advice; monitoring on-going. A question was asked about the Tour de Yorkshire and whether there would be rolling road-blocks. PC Bilton explained that it would probably be Police out-riders as in previous Tours.
